- 4) Dogs must be up to date on Distemper, Parvo, Corona, Rabies, and Kennel Cough (Bordetella) Vaccinations, Heartworm Check and Fecal Flotation.
- 5) Cats must be up to date on Feline Distemper, Chlamydia, Bordetella, Rabies Vaccinations and Fecal Flotation.
- 6) All boarding animals must be reasonably free from fleas and ticks. In order to maintain pest control we reserve the right to treat any animal at owner's expense for a fee of \$6.00-\$7.00 for fleas and \$17.00-\$21.00 for ticks.
- 7) It is agreed that any boarding animal that becomes sick will be treated by the veterinarian at the owner's expense.
- 8) If your pet is on a prescription diet (i.e. Hill's), and you do not supply the food, you will be charged by the bag or can(s).
- 9) The Cleveland Veterinary Hospital is not responsible for damage or loss of toys, leashes, collars, etc.
- 10) It is agreed that pets that are boarded together will be separated if they show signs of aggressiveness towards one another.
- 11) There will be a preboarding exam fee of \$20.50 for any pet that has not been examined by Cleveland Veterinary Hospital in the past 6 months.
